Annual Business and Labor Awards Dinner***

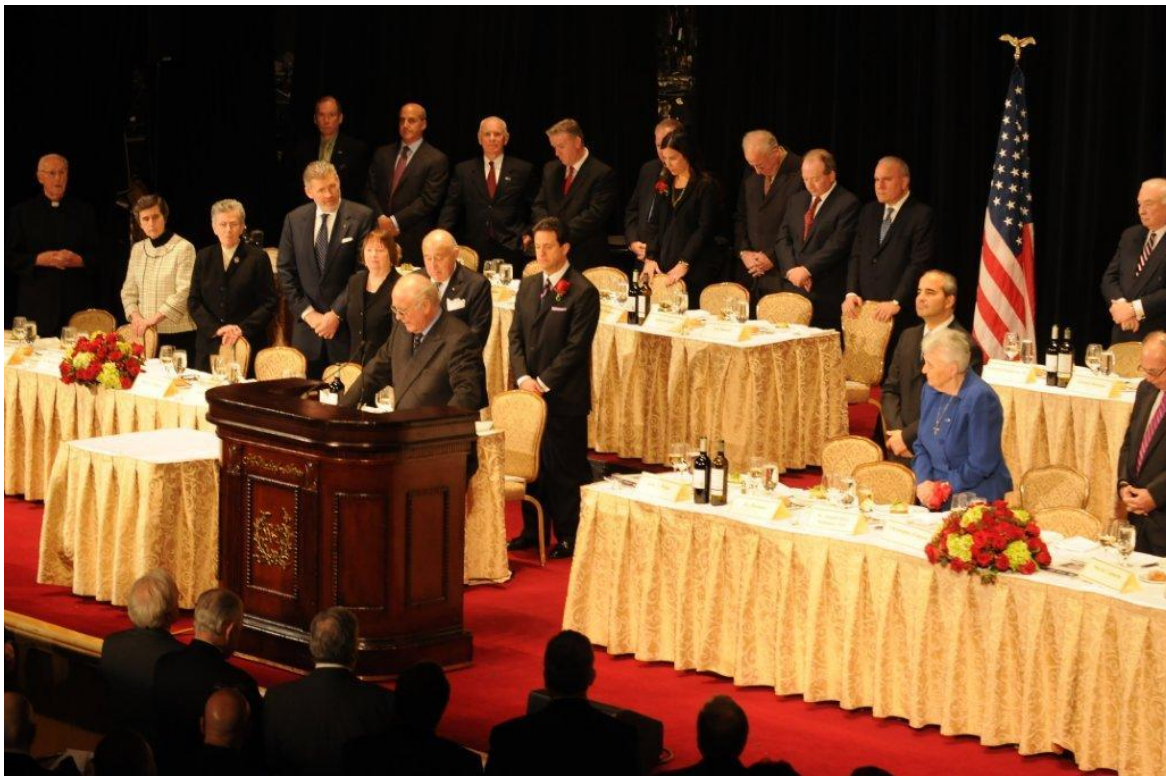
